



WELCOME TO DUNROBIN CASTLE

Dunrobin Castle is the historic home of the Earls and Dukes of Sutherland. The earliest part of the building dates from around 1275 and has a number of later extensions.

Your tour begins at the main staircase, which leads to the state rooms on the first floor. These include the Dining Room, set with the family silver, and our Library which has over 10,000 books. You then make your way to the smaller rooms in the older parts of the castle. The Tearoom and Gift Shop can be

found on the ground floor. Access to the Gardens is from the Entrance Hall.

Our Victorian Museum and Falconry displays can be found in the garden. See map on reverse.

Falconry displays daily at 11.30am
and 2pm from 1st April until the
30th September.
