### Clava Cairns | Culloden | Cawdor Castle | Loch Ness | Urguhart Castle



First, we travel to Clava Cairns, a mystical Bronze Age burial site surrounded by ancient standing stones, where you can soak in the peaceful atmosphere. Next, we step onto the haunting grounds of Culloden Battlefield, where the Jacobites fought their final battle in 1746—walk the battlefield and uncover the gripping history at the visitor centre.

From there, we make our way to the fairy-tale Cawdor Castle, famed for its ties to Shakespeare's Macbeth and its



stunning gardens. After exploring the castle, we pause for a delicious lunch at The Cawdor Tavern.

In the afternoon, we visit **Dochgarroch** Locks, where boats navigate the Caledonian Canal, before heading to the legendary Loch Ness. Here, we explore the dramatic ruins of Urguhart Castle, offering spectacular views over the loch. A perfect day of history, beauty, and adventure awaits!






